SPECIAL ELECTION

**County 1 Percent Sales and
Use Tax**
(Vote for One)

Shall a special 1 percent sales and use tax be imposed in Liberty County for a period of time of six (6) years and for the raising of an estimated amount of \$51,500,000 for the purpose of paying previously incurred indebtedness of Liberty County and funding the following capital outlay projects within Liberty County: (i) for Liberty County: acquisition, construction, and equipping of a new Justice Center for Liberty County and a new public library; repairing, replacing, constructing, and maintaining various drainage projects within the County; vehicles and equipment for county-wide fire protection; acquisition of real property, construction and renovation of recreational facilities including recreational equipment; improvements and expansion of the Liberty Annex East End, including renovations to the old Liberty Elementary School, including demolition, parking, establishment of a library, and construction of a swimming pool; renovations and improvements to the County Courthouse; architectural plans for expansion of the jail; expansion, renovations, and repair to the record retention center including a new roof; capital improvements to Midcoast Regional Airport; construction of a new animal control facility; new technology and upgrading of the County interoperable communications system; and public safety and hospital improvements, including necessary demolition and construction of a new EMS station and acquisition of ambulances and other equipment (ii) for the City of Hinesville: expansion, renovations, and improvements to City Hall and public works facilities, and (iii) for the County and the Cities of Hinesville, Midway, Riceboro, Walthourville, Allenhurst, Gum Branch, and Flemington: road, street and bridge purposes, which may include sidewalks, bicycle paths, and safety improvements?

If imposition of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of Liberty County in the principal amount of \$33,000,000 for the above purposes.
