OFFICIAL GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA NOVEMBER 4, 2008

To vote, blacken the Oval ( ) next to the candidate of your choice. To vote for a person not on the ballot, manually WRITE IN his or her name in the space provided, then blacken the corresponding Oval ( ). If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, blacken the corresponding Oval ( ). Use only pen or pencil. If you spoil your ballot, do not erase, but ask for a new ballot.

To determine that the voter is a registered voter in any other county or other state for any particular candidate, list or number, issue, or list of issues endorsed in the election consistent with an affidavit signed and a return under Georgia law (OCGA 21-2-285(b) and 21-2-303(d)).
