OFFICIAL GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA NOVEMBER 4, 2008

If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, mark the corresponding Oval (O). Use only pen or pencil. If you spoil your ballot, do not reuse, but ask for a new ballot.

Understand that the voter is irrevocable in choice in any other respect of vote in any particular candidate, set of candidates, issue, or for or against included in this election, including an act of voter fraud under Georgia law. (OCGA 17-7-30(b)(2) and 21-2-30(a))
