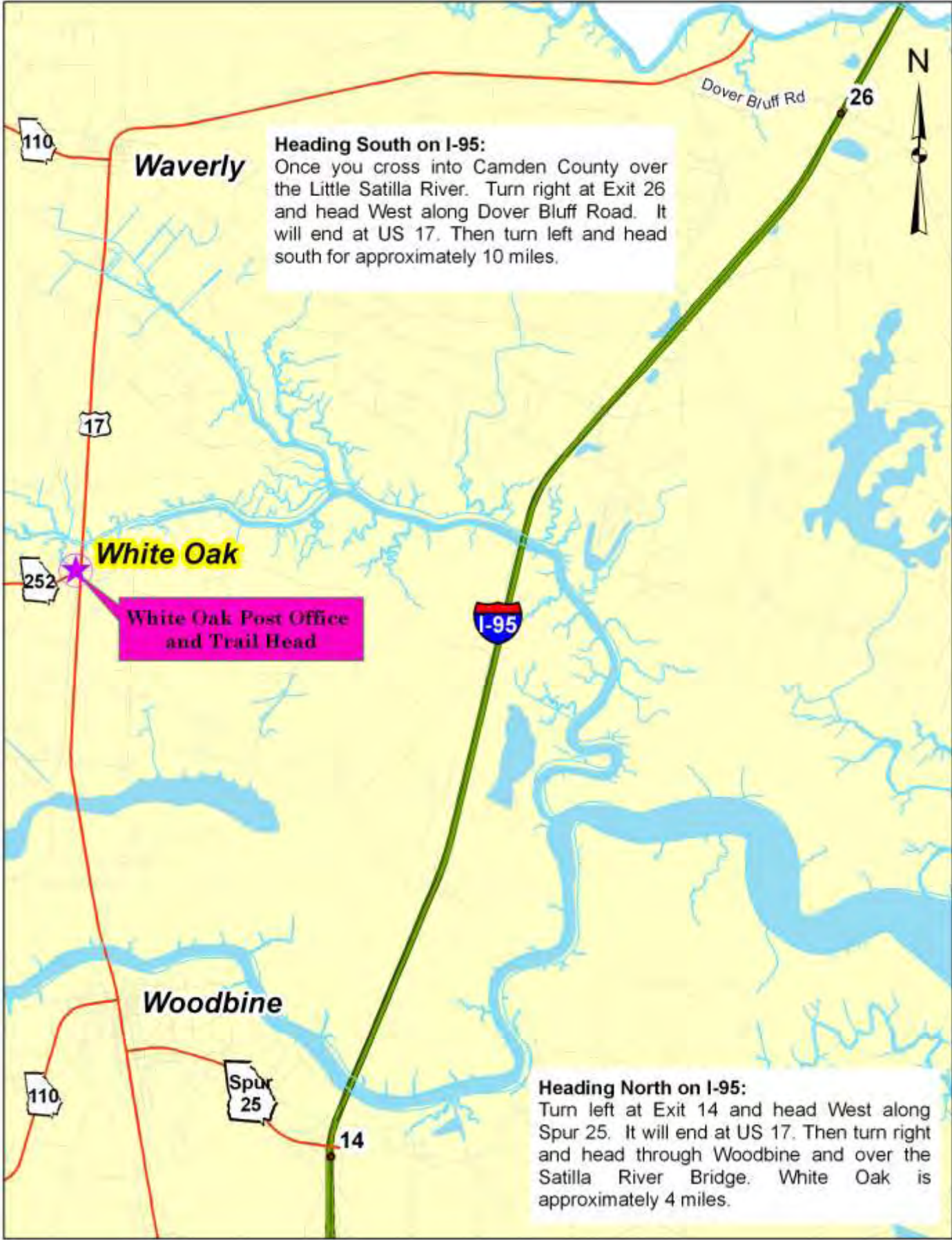

Heading South on I-95:
Once you cross into Camden County over the Little Satilla River. Turn right at Exit 26 and head West along Dover Bluff Road. It will end at US 17. Then turn left and head south for approximately 10 miles.

White Oak Post Office and Trail Head

Heading North on I-95:
Turn left at Exit 14 and head West along Spur 25. It will end at US 17. Then turn right and head through Woodbine and over the Satilla River Bridge. White Oak is approximately 4 miles.
